This past year VNU became aware that RIDES would be acquiring new buses and retiring some buses in their fleet. "We have a tremendous relationship with RIDES, and they were instrumental in helping us determine which bus would be the best fit in the VNU environment. The end result was our ability to purchase a RIDES bus we feel is a great fit for us." Jerry Postma- Director of Admissions and Quality Enhancement. Since the bus went into service on March 1st of this year, "Like the song says, The wheels on the bus go round and round, we've used it every day" commented Clark ledema, Community Program Supervisor, "Our whole program is designed around getting people into the community, and the bus can seat 9 individuals and a wheelchair, or 2 wheelchairs and 5 people, so it's especially helpful when we're taking different groups out into the community." "We already nicknamed it Fiona" said Clark.
